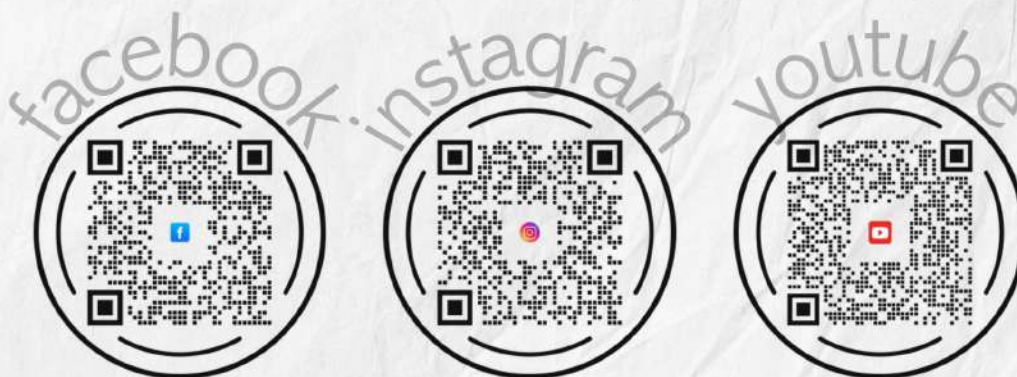

the nitty gritty about who's been doing what...



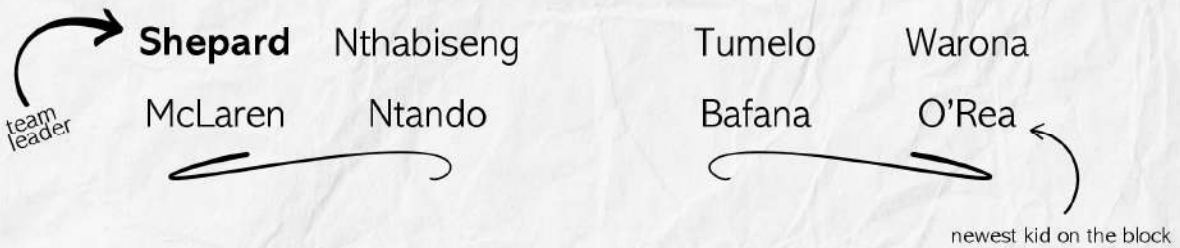

Media has been going very well and we'd like to give a special shout-out to Nyikiwe for the incredible work she's been doing and the initiative she's shown!

## youtube (@rbapchurch)

Our YouTube channel is doing well and is the central place where all Sunday sermons get posted. Over the last quarter, we also made all Prayer and Fasting evening sessions available online as well. In the past 90 days, we have gained over 212 views, generated more than 10.2 hours of watch time.

## website (rbapchurch.org)

Our website remains our second most important online space, beaten only by our socials. In the last 90 days, we have had over 397 site sessions with most connecting directly to the site, followed by those finding us on Google, Instagram, Facebook, and Bing respectively.

## facebook (@rbapchurch)

Our Facebook remains one of our most pivotal advertising and outreach platforms. In the last 90 days, we have had a reach of over 4,400 people with over 325 content interactions. We have also gained 11 followers and had over 19,600 views.

## facebook (@rbcaay)

Our Amplified Youth Facebook account has done moderately well considering most youth prefer Instagram. In the last 90 days, we've had reach of 107, 49 interactions, 2 new followers, and 1,200 views.

## instagram (rbapchurch.za)

Like Facebook, our Instagram is doing well, with slightly less uptake as the majority of targeted audience for our main church account use Facebook instead. In the last 90 days on Instagram, we've achieved a reach of 596, 400 content interactions, and gained 19 followers. We've also had over 6,400 views.

## instagram (amplifiedy)

On Instagram, our youth account has done very well. In the last 90 days, we've had reach of over 3,100, more than 459 content interactions, and grown by 34 followers. Our views have also exceeded 13,200.

# myRBC

As part of the last quarter, we have overhauled our website to offer increased security, better encryption, and the launch of the myRBC portal. This is split for partners and leaders and gives quick access to tools, resources, information, and everything else to help the church run smoothly.

## maintenance

Last year we completed multiple projects, including some that have been due for almost over two years. However, at the moment we are placing all maintenance on hold due to funds. Despite this, the following is planned for the year:



- Resealing of tea hall roof (+-R20,000)
- Maintenance and repaint of the kitchen (+-R15,000)
- New landscaping at front of the church (+-R10,000)
- Aircons for main sanctuary (+-R50,000)
- Renovation of bathrooms (including possible extension) (+-R75,000)
- Conversion of Storeroom to Children's Church Class (+-R50,000)
